Danish trade with Ghana

Export

- Ghana was Denmark's 74th largest export market in 2020, totalling DKK 1,2 billion in revenues which accounted for 0,1% of danish exports. (BOP)
- Ghana was Denmark's 83rd largest export market for goods with 382,3 million DKK (0,0%) and the 61st biggest market for services grossing 863,6 million DKK (0,2%). (BOP)
- Goods exports to Ghana rose by 10,4 % in 2021 in relation to 2020. (FOS)
- The top export in 2021 was machinery specialized for particular industries (DKK 52,2 million). (FOS)
- In the first month of 2022, Danish exports of goods to Ghana were worth DKK 11,5 million; a fall of 59,1% relative to the same time period in 2021 (DKK 28,1 million). (FOS)

Import

- Imports of goods and services from Ghana totalled DKK 958 million in 2020. (BOP)
- Imports of goods from Ghana totalled DKK 91 million in 2021; a fall of 38,5% relative to 2020.(FOS)
- The top import good in 2021 was oil seeds and oleaginous fruits (DKK 68,3 million). (FOS)
- In the first month of 2022, imports of goods from Ghana were worth DKK 1,4 million; a rise of 4,0% in relation to the same time period in 2021 (DKK 1,3 million). (FOS)

Foreign direct investments

- Data on direct investments between Denmark and Ghana are not available.
- Data on direct investments between Denmark and Ghana are not available.
- In 2020 21 danish subsidiaries employed 1.376 people in Ghana.

Economic key figures for Ghana

- Ghana is the world's 76th largest economy in 2020 with a GDP of 67 billion USD.
- In 2020 the country had a population of 31,1 million.
- According to the World Bank's 2021 classification, Ghana belongs to the group of Lower middle income countries. The GDP per capita of the country was 2.156 USD in 2020.
- In 2021 the real growth rate in GDP is expected to be 4,6 pct., and over the following two years real GDP is expected to grow at a rate of 4,6 pct. p.a.
- In 2020 the current account had a deficit of 3,2 pct. of GDP. Towards 2023, the current account is expected to somewhat worsen, but remains negative.
- In 2019 the government budget balance had a deficit of 11,2 pct. Towards 2023, the budget balance is expected to slightly improve, but remains negative.
- Exports of services to Ghana totalled DKK 864 million in 2020.
